Objective

- Enable anyone who is interested in interplanetary networking to learn about it quickly, at the level of detail that she will find most useful.
- To this end, assemble, organize, and maintain an annotated library of IPN documentation.

Scope

- Review and summarize the documentation currently hosted by the IPNSIG website.
- Draft a document tree structure that will achieve the objective of the WG.
- Instantiate the document tree structure on the IPNSIG website.
- Populate all branches of the structure. For each branch:
 - Notes on the nature of the documents (including videos) offered on the pages of this branch of the document tree.
 - Pages for relevant topics, each of which comprises paragraphs of descriptive narrative in which are embedded URLs by which documents can be accessed.

Milestones

- January 2021: finish review and summarization of currently hosted documents.
- February 2021: finish design of document tree.
- March 2021: add new document tree to the IPNSIG website.
- June 2021: finish initial population of the new document tree.
